



# PRE-CARE INSTRUCTIONS

## PERMANENT MAKE-UP

The results of your permanent make-up will be based on the health & quality of your skin. Results will vary from person to person. If you have a pre-existing skin condition or are on medication, you may still be eligible for the procedure but should adjust your expectations based on your situation.

It is very important that you inform us of all medication that you take! Please stop taking Omega Oils, natural supplements 5 days prior to the procedure. Do not take any pain medication 24hrs before the procedure. No alcohol or drugs to be taken 24 hrs beforehand. If you are allowed, take an anti-histamine tablet that will help with the swelling of the eyes. It could also dry the eyes slightly so that there is minimal tearing during the eyeliner procedure! Get your Dr's confirmation if you are on any chronic meds. You will need to stop using any Eye lash enhancing serum for 2 weeks, and remove eye extensions before an eye procedure.



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The use of Glaucoma eye drops can also cause excessive bleeding so get your Dr's approval to stop for a week before hand.

1 Those with oily skin may require an additional touch up.

2 please be aware that colour intensity will be significantly darker and sharper immediately & a few days after the initial procedure, but the colour will reduce by at least 50%

3 Do not take any pain medication or aspirin....

4 Please do not shape or wax your brows before the procedure. Your technician will shape your brows during the procedure  
No electrolysis, exfoliating treatments like microdermabrasion for 2 weeks prior to treatment

Botox, AHA products and retinoids should be avoided for 2 weeks prior to treatment

No chemical/laser peels for 6 weeks

If you suffer from cold sores/ fever blisters you **MUST** take an anti-viral prior and after procedure.
